CHANGE ORDER APPROVED - ADDITION
OF \$5300 TO CONTRACT OF S. J. O'JACK

Trustee Prakken supported by Trustee Withey moved/that an addition of \$5300 to the contract of S. J. O'Jack for pointing and caulking at Jones School. The addition is due to the fact that it is necessary to replace much more brick than was thought would originally be necessary. It was impossible to make this determination before getting into the job.
